THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Ratify exercising option to renew agreements with various universities, groups and individuals to provide external partner consulting services to the Office of Accountability at a cost not to exceed \$4,427,785 \$5,811,500.

Renewal Agreements exercising these options are currently being negotiated. No payment shall be made to Consultant(s) during the option period prior to the execution of these written option documents. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event written renewal agreements are not executed within 120 days of the date of this Board Report. Information pertinent to this option is stated below.

This amendment is necessary to: 1) add 21 schools, 2) reassign 2 schools, 3) increase the maximum compensation for 9 vendors by a total of \$1,383,715, 4) terminate one vendor, and 5) change the funding source for certain services provided by external partners relative to the Comprehensive School Reform Demonstration Grant (Accepted March 28, 2001). Written contract amendments are currently being prepared and a contract termination letter for the terminated vendor is currently being prepared. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind as to each vendor in the event a written amendment for such vendor is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Amended Board Report.

ORIGINAL AGREEMENT: The original Agreements (authorized by BR 99-0825-PR10 and BR 99-1215-PR23) were for terms of July 1, 1999 to June 30, 2000 as to 11 Consultants and terms of December 16, 1999 to June 30, 2000 as to three Consultants. All original agreements provided for two one-year options to renew.

OPTION PERIOD: The term of these agreements is being extended for one year commencing July 1, 2000 and ending June 30, 2001.

OPTION PERIODS REMAINING: There is one option period for one year remaining.

COMPENSATION: The Consultants shall be paid during this option period as periodic invoices are submitted and verified, in amounts not to exceed those listed above for each Consultant.

REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES: Consultant shall not be reimbursed for any expenses.

TERMINATION: Terminate the contract with National School Services to provide external partner services to Henson Elementary. Henson was reassigned to UIC-School of Education before National School Services commenced services. No services were provided by National School Services due to this reassignment. Authorize the General Counsel to issue a termination letter to National School Services.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written Option documents <u>and the amendments</u>. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the option documents <u>and the amendments</u>. Authorize the Chief Accountability Officer to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate these option agreements <u>and the amendments</u>.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: Vendors agree to comply with and be bound by the provisions of the Revised Remedial Plan for Minority and Women Business Enterprise Economic Participation (M/WBE Plan).

Actual M/WBE participation pursuant to this agreement cannot be determined at this time. M/WBE participation will be evidenced via standard monitoring procedures.

LSC REVIEW: Written approval by the Local School Council will be provided whenever the schools select to purchase consulting services using local school funds.

Inspector General – Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Board of Trustees has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness – The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726-EX3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics – The Board's Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-RU3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

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Contingent Liability - The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is deemed a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year budget(s).
