DESCRIPTION: The Council of the Great City Schools is a membership organization composed of 57 of the nation's largest urban public school systems. Its mission centers solely on the improvement of public schools for urban youth. The Council joins together urban school districts of unusually large size (cities with populations over 250,000 or student enrollments over 35,000) whose students come from diverse cultural and ethnic backgrounds. The Council also serves as a focal point for information exchange, conferencing and networking among urban school districts with similar interests, concerns and challenges. The legislative advocacy efforts are estimated to bring more than \$250 million in extra federal funds to urban districts or about \$200 for every dollar in dues.
