CLASSES BEGIN - Tuesday, September 4, 2001. Students are scheduled for a full day of school.

TEACHER INSTITUTE DAYS (†) - Friday, August 31, 2001; Friday, February 1, 2002; and Monday, June 24, 2002. On these days teachers are to report at the regular time. Institute days are non-attendance days for students and are days held or approved by the State Superintendent of Instruction for teacher inservice workshops or equivalent professional educational experiences such as educational gatherings, demonstrations of instructional materials, visitation of other schools, institutions or facilities.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT DAYS (#) - Wednesday, August 29, 2001; Thursday, August 30, 2001; Friday, November 9, 2001; Friday, March 29, 2002 and Friday, April 12, 2002. On these days teachers are to report at the regular time. These are non-attendance days for students. Professional development days are used for planning, evaluation and staff development.

REPORT CARD PICKUP/PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCE DAYS - Elementary schools on Wednesday, November 14, 2001 and Wednesday, May 1, 2002; high schools on Thursday, November 15, 2001 and Thursday, May 2, 2002. The elementary school dates are non-attendance days for students in elementary schools. The high school dates are non-attendance days for students in high schools.

REPORT CARD DISTRIBUTION DAYS - For second marking period, February 6, 2002; for fourth marking period, June 25, 2002.

WINTER VACATION - Schools close at the end of the school day on Friday, December 21, 2001 and reopen on Monday, January 7, 2002.

LOCAL SCHOOL COUNCIL ELECTIONS - Elections will be held on May 1 and 2, the third marking period report card pick-up days.

SPRING VACATION - Schools close for students at the end of the school day on Friday, April 12, 2002 and reopen on Monday, April 22, 2002.

GRADUATION DATES - Elementary school graduation dates may not be held prior to the week of June 17, 2002. High school graduation dates may not be held prior to Friday June 14, 2002.

KINDERGARTEN PRE-REGISTRATION - The suggested dates are April 22, 2002 through April 26, 2002.

SUMMER VACATION - Schools close for students on Tuesday, June 25, 2002.

REGULAR SUMMER SCHOOL SESSIONS FOR ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOLS

GRADES 3-6-8 SUMMER BRIDGE PROGRAM will operate for six and/or seven weeks beginning Monday, July 1, 2002 and ending Friday, August 16, 2002. HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER PROGRAM will operate for eight weeks beginning Monday, July 1, 2002 and ending Friday, August 23, 2002.
