## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SIGNATURE PROXY FOR BOARD PRESIDENT

WHEREAS, Board Rules 2-5.1 and 5-10.1, as amended on June 23, 1999 and September 26, 2001 and by their terms, require execution of a written contract for transactions involving expenditures for equipment, supplies, services, repairs, goods, wares, materials, work and merchandise exceeding \$10,000 and for personal services and consulting services exceeding \$25,000; and

WHEREAS, designation of a signature proxy by the Board President will facilitate the timely execution of contract documents;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO THAT:

- 1. Brandi Turco is hereby designated as the person authorized to serve as a signature proxy for the Board President Michael W. Scott.
- 2. As a signature proxy for Board President Michael W. Scott, Brandi Turco shall be authorized to sign contracts, contract amendments and contract extensions for Board President Michael W. Scott.
- 3. The signature of Brandi Turco as it will appear for Board President Michael W. Scott is appended hereto as Exhibit A.
- 4. This resolution shall be effective upon its adoptions and shall be effective until rescinded by further Board action.
