## ADJUST THE ATTENDANCE AREA FOR TWAIN AND HEARST ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

## THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

Effective July 1, 2002, change the attendance area for Mark Twain elementary school, located at 5131 South Linder Avenue, and for Phobe Apperson Hearst elementary school, located at 4640 South Lamon Avenue. This change is not applicable to students currently enrolled at Twain.

**DESCRIPTION:** 

With this change, a portion of the Twain's attendance area is assigned to the Hearst attendance area, to relieve overcrowding at Twain.

<u>The Comprehensive Student Assignment Plan</u>, adopted by the Board of Education on January 22, 1982 (Board Report 82-12), states: "The Board will seek to eliminate overcrowded schools to the greatest extent practicable considering all circumstances."

Beginning at Laramie Avenue and 49<sup>th</sup> Street
East to Kenton Avenue (Belt Railroad)
South to 55<sup>th</sup> Street
West to Central Avenue
South to 59<sup>th</sup> Street (extended)
West to I H B Railroad
North to 55<sup>th</sup> Street
West to Meade Avenue
North to 51<sup>st</sup> Street
East to Laramie Avenue
North to the starting point.

## Adjusted Attendance Area Boundary for Hearst Elementary School

Grades kindergarten through eighth:

Beginning at Laramie Avenue and the Illinois-Michigan Drainage Canal Northeast to La Crosse Avenue (city limits)
North to Pershing Road (extended, city limits)
East to Kenton Avenue (Belt Railroad)
South to 49<sup>th</sup> Street
West to Laramie Avenue
