PAYMENT TERM: The payments made hereunder are for services rendered from October 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: Each consultant worked with schools to provide technical support in the areas of organization, curriculum, instruction and evaluation, to assist the principal and school staff in their efforts to achieve stated comprehensive school reform initiatives. Examples of activities included providing staff development in core curricular areas of instruction, assisting with the implementation of Children First activities, assisting school administrators with leadership concerns, providing sample and demonstration lessons for teachers, fostering parent and community partnerships and coaching school staff on the effective use of data to drive the instructional practices of the school. The consultant made site visits to each school, and conferred with the principal to problem-solve areas of concern.

Similar to the use of external partners for the schools on probation, these curriculum partners provided a support system for schools not on probation yet with chronically marginal percentages of their students failing to meet the expected standards on the ISAT. Additionally an inordinate number of students in these schools were performing below grade and age level expectations on the lowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS).

DELIVERABLES: Deliverables varied according to each consultant's proposal and the identified needs of the particular school. All services focused on improving reading achievement and comprehensive school reform initiatives. The Office of the Chief Education Officer monitored the delivery of deliverables of each consultant.

OUTCOMES: Consultant's services 1) increased student achievement; 2) improved effectiveness of the school leaders in the areas of school organization and fiscal management; 3) fostered a student-centered climate; 4) provided quality professional development activities; and 5) promoted parent and community partnerships.

COMPENSATION: Each consultant shall be paid immediately in the amounts shown above, with total compensation not to exceed \$3,251,249.00 in the aggregate.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written agreements. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the agreement.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: A review of minority and women business participation was precluded due to completed performance of all services.

LSC REVIEW: Local School Council approval is not applicable to this report.

CREDIT/CHARGE: Sundry units - 239 - 631 - 8923 - Objects

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General - Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts - The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one-year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness - The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted July 26, 1995 (95-0726-EX3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics - The Board's Ethics Code adopted September 27, 1995 (95-0927-RU3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability - The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is deemed a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year budget(s).
