ADJUST ATTENDANCE BOUNDARIES FOR CHARLES STEINMETZ & WILLIAM TAFT HIGH SCHOOLS

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

Effective immediately, adjust attendance boundaries for Charles P. Steinmetz High School, located at 3030 North Mobile Avenue and William H. Taft High School, located at 6530 West Bryn Mawr Avenue. This change is not applicable to students currently enrolled at Steinmetz High School.

DESCRIPTION:

These changes are necessary to more evenly distribute utilization rates between Charles P. Steinmetz, and William Howard Taft High Schools. Steinmetz is an overcrowded high school while Taft has excess capacity. Both schools have adjacent attendance boundaries. This action assigns a portion of Steinmetz' northern attendance area to Taft.

Adjust Attendance Area Boundary for Taft High School

Grades ninth through twelfth:

Beginning at the Des Plaines River and Higgins Road Along the city limits to Devon Avenue and Pulaski Road South to Lawrence Avenue West to Elston Avenue Southeast to Kiona Avenue West along Wilson (extended) to Milwaukee Avenue Northwest to Lawrence Avenue West to Linder Avenue South to Sunnyside Avenue West to Central Avenue South to Montrose Avenue West to Menard Avenue South to Irving Park Road East to Central Avenue South to Addison Street West to Overhill Avenue South to Cornelia Avenue West to Opal Avenue South to Roscoe Street West to Orange Avenue South to Belmont Avenue Follow city limits west to the Des Plaines River Follow the Des Plaines River north and west along the city limits to starting point.

Adjust Attendance Area Boundary for Steinmetz High School

Grades ninth through twelfth:

Beginning at Orange Avenue and Roscoe Street
East to Opal Avenue
North to Cornelia Avenue
East to Overhill Avenue
North to Addison Street
East to Central Avenue
South to North Avenue
West to Harlem Avenue following the city boundary
North to Wellington Avenue
West to Oriole Avenue

North to Belmont Avenue West to Orange Avenue North to the starting point.
