# ADJUST THE ATTENDANCE BOUNDARY OF PHILLIPS AND ESTABLISH LOCAL SCHOOL COUNCIL VOTING DISTRICT FOR DUSABLE HIGH SCHOOL

#### THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

Effective July 1, 2003, adjust the attendance boundary of Wendell Phillips Academy, located at 244 East Pershing Road and establish Jean Baptiste Point DuSable High School, located at 4934 South Wabash Avenue as a multi-attendance area school. This change is not applicable to students currently enrolled at Phillips Academy School.

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

Effective July 1,2003, the Jean Baptiste Point DuSable High School will not have a defined neighborhood attendance area. The described voting district boundary is the same as the current attendance boundary for DuSable High School.
