CLOSE THE ARTS OF LIVING ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

That the Chicago Board of Education close the Arts of Living Alternative School, located at 1855 North Sheffield Avenue, at the end of the 2002-2003 school year.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to the Board of Education's Policy on the Closing and Consolidation of Schools. 02-0424-PO2 ("the Policy"), by the date of the annual May Board meeting and following a public hearing, the Chief Executive Officer of the Chicago Public Schools ("CEO") may recommend to the Board the closing of schools for any of the reasons for such action stated in the Policy.

On April 25, 2003, the CEO proposed that the Arts of Living Alternative School be closed due to the underutilization of the school and the fact that the special student population the school was intended to serve, expectant mothers, could be adequately served at other existing schools. Pursuant to the Policy, a public hearing was convened on May 6, 2003, pursuant to proper notice to receive public comment on the CEO's proposal. An independent hearing officer received comments and supporting documents at the hearing. The hearing officer has prepared a report including findings regarding the CEO's proposal. After receiving the hearing officer's report, the CEO has determined to recommend that the Board close the Arts of Living Alternative School at the end of the 2002-2003 school year.

Pursuant to the Policy, the Local School Council of Arts of Living will be dissolved effective the end of the 2002-2003 school year as a result of the closing of Arts of Living Alternative School. Also pursuant to the Policy, the regularly certified and appointed teachers of Arts of Living will become reassigned teachers pursuant to the Policy on the "Reassignment and Layoff of Regularly Certified and Appointed Teachers Due to Changes in Staffing Needs," 97-0723-PO2. Pursuant to Section V of the Board-approved Uniform Principal's Performance Contract form, the contract of the Principal of Arts of Living Alternative School will terminate effective the end of the 2002-2003 school year.
