That this Request for Dismissal and charges and specifications preferred by the Chief Executive Officer against Mary Dampf be approved; that notice of her dismissal and a copy of this Board Report and accompanying charges and specifications be served upon her within ten (10) days of adoption of the Board Report.

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Mary Dampf, an educational sigh language interpreter currently assigned to the M. Jackson School, 917 West 88th Street, Chicago, Illinois 60620, with being absent without leave; failure to apply for an approved leave of absence after ten consecutive days of absence; excessive absences; repeated or flagrant acts of Group 2 misconduct; and conduct unbecoming a Chicago Public Schools' employee.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Mary Dampf from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Mary Dampf has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Mary Dampf without pay.

She will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.
