APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BRAINFOREST INC. FOR THE PRODUCTION OF AN EARLY CHILDHOOD VIRTUAL KINDERGARTEN WEBSITE AND CD-ROM

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an agreement with Brainforest, Inc. for the production of the "Early Childhood - Virtual Kindergarten" website and CD-Rom in both English and Spanish for the Office of Early Childhood Education (OECE) at a cost not to exceed \$93,030. Consultant was selected on a non-competitive basis because of the quality of previous work in preschool education and because consultant is original architect of the Virtual Classroom website, CD-ROMs and National Network platform. A written agreement for Consultant's services is currently being negotiated. No services shall be provided by Consultant and no payment shall be made to Consultant prior to the execution of the written agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written agreement is not executed within 60 days of the date of this Board Report. TERM: The term of this agreement shall commence on the date the agreement is signed and shall end on June 30, 2004.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: Consultant will produce a bilingual website and CD-Rom to support 10 lessons designed by an OECE-designated curriculum team of Chicago Public Schools kindergarten teachers. Consultant will add a new home page and additional links for kindergarten audience. New success chart will be added for new lessons and there will be an expanded around town calendar. Content for these areas will be developed and provided by CPS teacher and early childhood staff. The site will continue to be maintained and updated by staff within the Office of Early Childhood Education. Consultant will design and develop a CD-Rom master in English and Spanish with content from the Virtual Kindergarten video hour that will work in conjunction with the Virtual Kindergarten website.

DELIVERABLES: Consultant will expand the current Virtual Pre-K website to include Kindergarten lessons. Consultant will deliver CD-ROM masters, one in English and one in Spanish.

OUTCOMES: Consultants services will result in 1) teaching resource for teachers and parents of kindergarten children 2) parents shown that they can teach their children through everyday activities at home 3) parents shown the importance of engaging their children in these types of activities regularly.

COMPENSATION: Consultant shall be paid as follows: 50% upon the signing of the contract, 50% upon delivery of final accepted product with the total compensation not to exceed \$93,030.

AUTHORIZATION: Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written agreement. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the agreement. Authorize the Office of Early Childhood Education Chief Officer to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate this agreement.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: The M/WBE Goals for this contract include:35% total MBE, 22% total African American,10% total Hispanic, 2% total Asian and 5% total WBE.

However, the Waiver Review Committee recommends that a partial waiver of the M/WBE Participation goals for this

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contract as required by the Revised Remedial Plan be granted because the contract scope is not further divisible.
