DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES: The Children First Fund issued stipend payments for 200 Summer Fellows in the amount of \$2000 each. This allowed the Fellows to be paid in a timely manner during the transition period between the end of the FY04 fiscal year and the loading of the budget for FY05, when funds for this purpose could be accessed by the Department of Human Resources. Stipend payments for each of the Summer Fellows were made in three installments on July 9th, July 23rd and August 6th in increments of \$666.00.

COMPENSATION: Payments to reimburse the Children First Fund will be made as follows: \$ 300,000 upon adoption of this Board report and \$100,000 no later than September 30, 2004, not to exceed the sum of \$400,000.
