RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO REGARDING THE DISMISSAL OF CORRINE RINCK, TENURED TEACHER, ASSIGNED TO FULTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34-85 of the Illinois School Code, 105 ILCS 5/34-85, a hearing was conducted before an impartial hearing officer, Arthur Medow, appointed by the Illinois State Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, after the conclusion of the dismissal hearing afforded Corrine Rinck, the hearing officer made written findings of fact and conclusions of law, and recommended reinstatement of Corrine Rinck; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago has reviewed the post-hearing briefs and hearing transcript ("record"), along with the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation of the hearing officer regarding the dismissal charges preferred against Corrine Rinck; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago finds that the facts do not constitute cause and grounds for her dismissal; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago that Corrine Rinck be reinstated;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>: After considering the hearing officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation, and after a thorough review of the entire record of the dismissal hearing, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago adopts the recommendation of the hearing officer.
- <u>Section 2</u>: This decision by the Board to adopt the hearing officer's recommendation should not be considered precedent for future cases.
- <u>Section 3</u>: Corrine Rinck is hereby reinstated to her former position with the Board of Education of the City of Chicago.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take full force and effect upon its adoption.

THEREFORE, this Resolution is hereby adopted/rejected by the members of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago on December 15, 2004.
