RESCIND WARNING RESOLUTION – LISA ZOCCOL!, TEACHER, ASSIGNED TO TWAIN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That the Board of Education of the City of Chicago rescind a Warning Resolution previously issued to Lisa Zoccoli, Board Report No. 04-0825-EX10.

DESCRIPTION:

A Warning Resolution was issued to Lisa Zoccoli at the August 25, 2004 meeting of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, Board Report No. 04-0825-EX10, informing her that she was in violation of the Board's residency policy, and directing her to become a resident of the city of Chicago by February 28, 2005. Subsequently, Ms. Zoccoli demonstrated that she was qualified for a special needs waiver under Section 8 of the Board's residency policy because she was "previously and continuously eligible for a waiver since the Board adopted the waiver policy on August 22, 2001." The Department of Human Resources granted Ms. Zoccoli a special needs waiver in accordance with the residency policy in January 2005. Consequently, Ms. Zoccoli is not in violation of the Board's residency policy and remediation is not required.

Based on the above, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago rescinds Warning Resolution Board Report No. 04-0825-EX10 issued to Lisa Zoccoli at its August 25, 2004 meeting.
