RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO REGARDING THE DISMISSAL OF WILLIAM CALHOUN, CHILD WELFARE ATTENDANT, ASSIGNED TO CANTY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

WHEREAS, pursuant to Board of Education of the City of Chicago policy and procedure, hearing officer Thomas Owens from the Board's Office of Labor and Employee Relations conducted a hearing on charges that William Calhoun should be dismissed; and

WHEREAS, after the conclusion of the dismissal hearing afforded William Calhoun, the hearing officer made written findings of fact and conclusions of law, and recommended the dismissal of William Calhoun; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago has reviewed the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation of the hearing officer regarding the dismissal charges preferred against William Calhoun; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago finds that the findings of fact constitute cause and grounds for his dismissal; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago that the best interests of the Chicago Public Schools require William Calhoun's dismissal;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, as follows:

Section 1: The Board of Education of the City of Chicago has considered and adopts the hearing officer's findings of fact and conclusions of law and accepts his recommendation to dismiss William Calhoun from employment with the Board.

<u>Section 2</u>: William Calhoun is hereby dismissed from employment with the Board of Education of the City of Chicago.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take full force and effect upon its adoption.

THEREFORE, this Resolution is hereby adopted/rejected by the members of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago on February 23, 2005.
