The original agreement was awarded on a competitive basis pursuant to a duly advertised Bid Solicitation (Specification 04-250198).

OPTION PERIOD: The term of this agreement is being extended for 1 year commencing October 1, 2006 and ending September 30, 2007.

OPTION PERIODS REMAINING: There is one option period for 12 months remaining.
