THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That the Chicago Board of Education adopt a Warning Resolution for Leotha Jones and that a copy of the Board Report and Warning Resolution be served upon Leotha Jones.
