ADOPT THE 2007-2008 YEAR ROUND CALENDARS

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Adopt the year-round calendars for the period of July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

DESCRIPTION: The calendars indicate holidays, teacher institute days, professional development days, and days when schools are closed for extended periods of time.

The 2007-2008 calendars for Tracks A, B, C, D and E include 170 pupil attendance days, 4 staff development days for School Improvement Planning, 2 parent-teacher conference days and 4 teacher institute days.


