**EDUCATIONAL VALUE/OUTCOMES:** Students in the Language Academy Program studied a curriculum which emphasized our country's democracy and heritage and this tour provided the students with an opportunity to observe first hand the sites, documents, etc. with regard to U.S. history and government. The students and their teachers followed a prescribed itinerary to sites of historical interest related to the curriculum.
