ORIGNIAL AGREEMENT: The original agreement (authorized by Board Report 07-1024-PR11) is for a term beginning on October 25, 2007 and ending June 30, 2008 with the Board having two options to renew for periods of one (1) year each.

OPTION PERIOD: This agreement is being renewed for a term commencing on July 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2009.

OPTION PERIODS REMAINING: There is one option to renew remaining.

SCOPE OF SERVICES: Microsoft will continue to provide premier support services which consists of the following:

- 720 support assistance hours
- 200 hours for problem resolution support
- Technical account management support
- Unlimited access to premier subscriber website

DELIVERABLES: Microsoft will continue to provide the following:

- An assigned resource for a single point of contact
- Workshops
- Problem resolution support based on Microsoft applications
- Support assistance for applications other than Microsoft
- Microsoft knowledge assistance

OUTCOMES: Microsoft's services will result in:

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members

during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness – The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted June 26, 1996 (96-0626-PO3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics – The Board's Ethics Code adopted June 23, 2004 (04-0623-PO4), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability – The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is deemed a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year budget(s).
