- WHEREAS, as Director of External Resource and Partnerships, Cynthia Greenleaf also developed or managed such initiatives as the Free Things page and program, the Future Exchanges Program, CPS Family Tree project, and individual donations garnering resources and or support needed to strengthen and expand educational opportunities of Chicago's students; and
- WHEREAS, Cynthia Greenleaf is known for her advocacy, innovation and dedication to education and the district; and
- WHEREAS, Cynthia Greenleaf's commitment and tireless efforts to improve the Chicago Public Schools will leave a lasting impact throughout our schools and communities.
