## RESOLUTION RE: APPOINTMENT OF TEACHER REPRESENTATIVES TO LOCAL SCHOOL COUNCILS TO FILL TEACHER REPRESENTATIVE VACANCIES FOR THE TERM OF OFFICE ENDING JUNE 30, 2010
