APPROVE SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLANS FOR SCHOOLS ON PROBATION AND FOR SCHOOLS WITH NCLB SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT STATUS

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

Approve School Improvement Plans for Advancing Academic Achievement (SIPAAAs) for schools on probation and for schools with NCLB school improvement status.

HISTORY: For schools identified on Exhibit A, school improvement plans were originally completed in Spring 2008 and, for schools on probation in the 2007-2008 school year, approved by the Board in February 2009 (BR 09-0225-EX18). Subsequent to the completion of these plans, Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) implemented an electronic e-plan system that necessitated updates to the CPS SIPAAA materials and all SIPAAAs previously approved by the Board. As a result, schools were directed to update and resubmit their 2008-2010 SIPAAAs in order to answer additional questions. The updated SIPAAAs were submitted to the Area Instruction Offices or the AMPS Officer and reviewed by the Area Instruction Officers or AMPS Officer and the individual principals prior to being submitted to the Chief Executive Officer. In addition, ISBE directed the Chicago Public Schools to develop and submit school improvement plans for charter schools in NCLB school improvement status and identified on Exhibit B. These SIPAAAs were submitted to the Office of New Schools and reviewed by the Executive Officer of the Office of New Schools and the individual charter operators prior to being submitted to the Chief Executive Officer.

DESCRIPTION: The Chief Executive Officer is requesting approval of the SIPAAAs for the 381 schools noted on the attached Exhibits A and B as required by ISBE. These schools were on probation during the 2007-08 or 2008-09 school years and/or in NCLB school improvement status in the 2008-2009 school year. These plans include specific steps that the Local School Councils and/or school staff must take to correct deficiencies and specific objective criteria by which the schools' subsequent progress shall be judged. Exhibit A excludes schools that closed at the end of the 2008-2009 school year.

Individual plans were developed collaboratively at each school with the assistance of the Office of Strategy and Planning, Office of Research, Evaluation, and Accountability, Office of Management and Budget, Area Instruction Offices, AMPS Office, or the Office of New Schools, Local School Councils, parent and community representatives, and school personnel. Once submitted to the Area Offices, AMPS Office, or Office of New Schools, SIPAAAs were reviewed to ensure that: areas in need of improvement were addressed and that the stated targets and activities were consistent with trend analyses and analysis of current conditions.

Each school's SIPAAA includes specific expenditures directly calculated to correct educational and operational deficiencies that resulted in the school being placed on probation or in school improvement status. All schools appended a Parent Compact and a Parent Involvement Policy to the SIPAAA. All non-charter schools also appended technology plans and attendance plans. All non-charter high schools appended Advanced Placement (AP) plans. Many plans included the following actions: implementing new reading and mathematics programs, providing professional development, implementing reduced class size, purchasing instructional materials, and teaching reading at the high school level.

Monitoring of and support for these SIPAAAs will be the responsibility of the Chief Area Offices or the Office of New Schools with the assistance of the Chief Education Office, the Office of Management and Budget, the Chief Performance Office, and the Office of Grants Management and Administration. The Chief Area Officer is authorized to modify a probation school's SIPAAA as necessary to correct deficiencies throughout the school year. Copies of the fully executed SIPAAAs are available in the Chief Area Offices or the Office of New Schools.
