ESTABLISH THE NEW AVONDALE-IRVING AREA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND ITS ATTENDANCE AREA BOUNDARIES AND ADJUST THE ATTENDANCE AREA BOUNDARIES FOR JOHN BARRY, FRANK W. REILLY, JAMES MONROE, AND JONATHAN Y. SCAMMON ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS, AND THURGOOD MARSHALL MIDDLE SCHOOL

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

That the Board approve the establishment, opening and attendance boundary of a new elementary school, effective July 1, 2010, to be known on a temporary basis as Avondale-Irving Area Elementary School located at 3231 North Springfield Avenue and adjust the attendance area boundaries for John Barry Elementary School ("Barry") located at 2828 North Kilbourn Avenue, James Monroe Elementary School ("Monroe") located at 3651 West Schubert Avenue, Frank W. Reilly Elementary School ("Reilly") located at 3650 West School Street, and Jonathan Y. Scammon ("Scammon") located at 4201 West Henderson Street, and adjust the attendance area boundaries for Thurgood Marshall Middle School ("Marshall") located at 3900 N. Lawndale Avenue.

A public hearing was held on August 21, 2009 at the Chicago Public School Board Chambers located at 125 South Clark Street discussing the new elementary school and proposed boundary changes.

DESCRIPTION:

Effective July 1, 2010, the Avondale-Irving Area Elementary School will open at 3231 North Springfield Avenue as a neighborhood school and serve approximately 900 students in grades Pre-K through eighth grade beginning in the 2010-2011 school year. A formal school name shall be assigned by the Board prior to Sept. 1, 2010 in accordance with the procedures identified for the naming of new schools identified in the Board's Policy on Naming and Re-Naming Schools (Board Report 03-0326-PO4). Initially, the Avondale-Irving Area Elementary School will establish a transitional advisory body. A Local School Council will be established in a timely matter.

All the students in grades kindergarten through seventh residing within the attendance area for the Avondale-Irving Area Elementary School and currently attending Monroe, Reilly, or Scammon will be transferred to the Avondale-Irving Area Elementary School to commence their next school year in September 2010 at the Avondale-Irving Area Elementary School. Students who do not wish to attend the new Avondale-Irving Area Elementary School must apply for (re)enrollment at Monroe, Reilly, or Scammon through the Board's Open Enrollment program. Enrollment at Monroe, Reilly, or Scammon of students who reside outside the new attendance area are subject to available space and other conditions as set out in the Open Enrollment provisions of the Board's Policy on Enrollment and Transfer of Students in the Chicago Public Schools (Board Report 08-0927-PO2). These changes are necessary in order to open Avondale-Irving Area Elementary School while relieving the overcrowding in the area.

First grade through fifth grade students that currently attend Barry who reside within the new attendance boundary for Scammon will be (transferred to Scammon. The assigned middle school for the students residing within the Barry boundary is currently Marshall Middle School. Pursuant to the boundary changes identified below, 7th and 8th grade students residing in the portion of the Barry boundary that is being reassigned to Scammon will be assigned to Scammon instead of Marshall Middle.

Pursuant to the Board of Education's Policy on the Review and Establishment of School Attendance Boundaries, 05-0622-PO1, a public hearing was convened on Friday, August 21, 2009, following the issuance of proper notice to receive public comment on the CEO's proposal to establish Avondale-Irving Area Elementary School and its attendance area boundary and adjust the attendance areas of Barry, Monroe, Reilly, and Scammon elementary schools. An independent hearing officer received oral and/or written comments and supporting documents at the hearing and kept the record open after the hearing to receive additional written comments or documentation. The hearing officer has prepared and submitted a report regarding the CEO's proposal in which the hearing officer recommends establishing Avondale-Irving Area Elementary School and its attendance area boundary and adjusting the attendance area boundaries of Barry, Monroe, Reilly, and Scammon. After receiving the hearing officer's report, the CEO has determined to recommend that the Board approve the establishment of Avondale-Irving Area Elementary School and its attendance area boundary and adjust the attendance area boundaries of Barry, Monroe, Reilly, and Scammon elementary schools beginning July 1, 2010.
