That the Board of Education of the City of Chicago rescind a Warning Resolution previously issued to Susan Baley on October 28, 2009 Board Report No. 09-1028-EX8.

DESCRIPTION:

A Warning Resolution was issued to Susan Baley at the October 28, 2009 meeting of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, Board Report No. 09-1028-EX8 in accordance with the provisions of the Employee Discipline and Due Process Policy. Subsequent to the issuance of the Warning Resolution, a Complaint for Administrative Review was filed in the Circuit Court of Cook County contesting the issuance of the Warning Resolution. On October 6, 2010, the Honorable Judge Rita Novak of the Circuit Court of Cook County, Chancery Division, found that there was insufficient evidence to find that Susan Baley engaged in the conduct described in the Warning Resolution, and ordered that the Warning Resolution be rescinded.

Based on the above, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago rescinds Warning Resolution Board Report No. 09-1028-EX8.
