The original Agreement (authorized by Board Report # 08-1119-PR17) in the amount of \$300,000.00 is for a term commencing January 23, 2009 and ending January 22, 2011, with the Board having 1 option to renew for a 12 month term. The original agreement was awarded on a competitive basis pursuant to Board Rule 7-2.
