
Broken out by School Year

Number of Students Enrolled on 15th Day


Broken out by Grade Band

Broken out by Race/Ethnicity




Enrollment declined among Black/African American students but increased for all other racial/ethnic groups, with the biggest increase seen among Latinx students.

Broken out by Priority Group




Enrollment increased among all priority groups in SY25, with the largest increases seen among State English Learners.

Broken out by **Grade Band**



Broken out by **Priority Group**




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All priority groups' attendance through 15th Day slightly increased from SY24 to SY25.
